... Christmas Lunch! Look, all those yummy cakes I baked are for you, Mr Bear. Nomm . . .



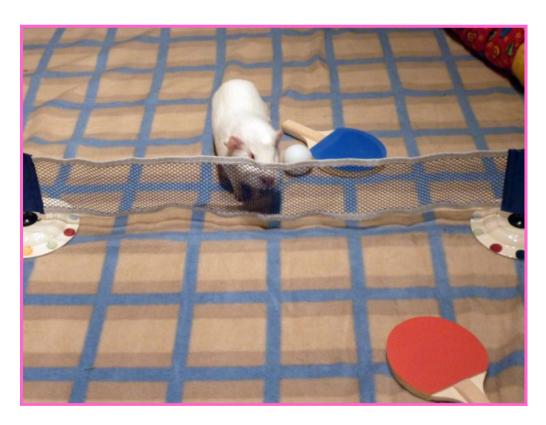


nomm, nomm, nomm, burp! Oops! Pardon. nomm, nomm, nomm nomm.

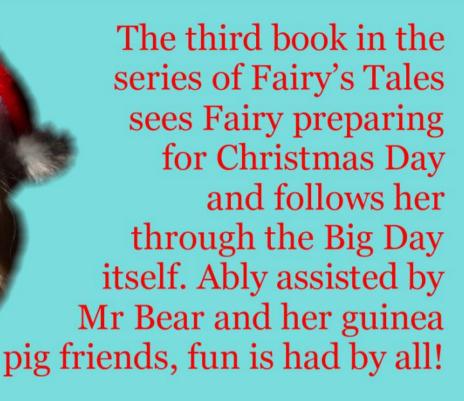
